



Plug Plants

Plug plants are small plantlets typically grown in trays of 30 cells. The plug plants we grow are usually choice perennial species that are difficult or slow to grow from seed. Plug plants can be used on their own or to enhance existing areas by directly adding more wildflower species. They may also be used in areas where seed sowing is more problematic such as wet areas or slopes. On steep banks they can be used in conjunction with hydroseeding to enhance stabilisation – see [Hydroseeding and Erosion Control](#).

Plug plants provide:

- High reliability
- Ease of planting and management
- Flowering period – spring through autumn
- Attraction to wildlife and enhancement of biodiversity
